SUMMARY REPORT

- We are looking for proof-readers for PNAI Summary Report 2024. Those who would like to help in editing the report's language in early December, please contact Maikki.
- The next PNAI MWG call is planned for 6.12.
- 1. The fifth online meeting in 2024 of the Policy Network on Artificial Intelligence (PNAI) Multistakeholder Working Group (MWG) took place on 21 November 2024 at 13 UTC.
- 2. The meeting was hosted by the MAG appointed facilitator of the PNAI and the IGF Secretariat's PNAI Consultant. The final version of the Agenda is attached to this document as Annex A1 and a list of meeting participants as Annex A2. The list of shared documents is annexed as A3.
- 3. The hosts opened the meeting and shared an update on the current progress. Preparations for PNAI Policy Report 2024 are at the last stage. The summary report includes two-page versions of the thematic reports prepared by the Sub-groups. Those who would like to volunteer to proof-read the reports, please contact Maikki. We will publish all the reports (Policy Report + four thematic reports) on PNAI website when they are all ready.
- 4. The main topic of the meeting was PNAI's session at the IGF Annual meeting. The session will take place on the second conference day Tuesday 17 December in Riyadh and online. A draft concept for PNAI's session has been available in Google docs for comments and speaker ideas since September.
 - We will organize a panel discussion; speakers will be asked to share their thoughts on the four PNAI reports. There will be time for audience questions. Audience can attend and ask questions both on-site as well as online.



- 5. A lively discussion on suggested speakers and speaker ideas ensued. Attendees shared suggestions and the current situation will be kept up to date and available to everyone in the Session concept in Google Docs.
 - Audace has contacted Saudi Arabian delegation and ICT minister of Rwanda. More women speakers are needed. It is very important to consider diversity, geographic split, gender and stakeholder group balance. This year we have 75 minutes, therefore it is important to keep the number of speakers low.
 - The idea is to hear feedback to the 2024 PNAI reports. The discussion should stay close to the report topics. PNAI members who have written the reports should not be speakers in the panel because we want to hear the outside view.
 - In addition to panelists, two moderators (on-site and online) and two rapporteurs are needed.
- 6. A catchy name and an informative description of the session will be created for the conference agenda. The goal is to finalize these as soon as possible, the current suggestions are open for comments and edits in Google Docs.
- 7. Marketing is very important to attract on-site and online attendees and raise awareness on the report. Creating a virtual poster with QR code was proposed.
