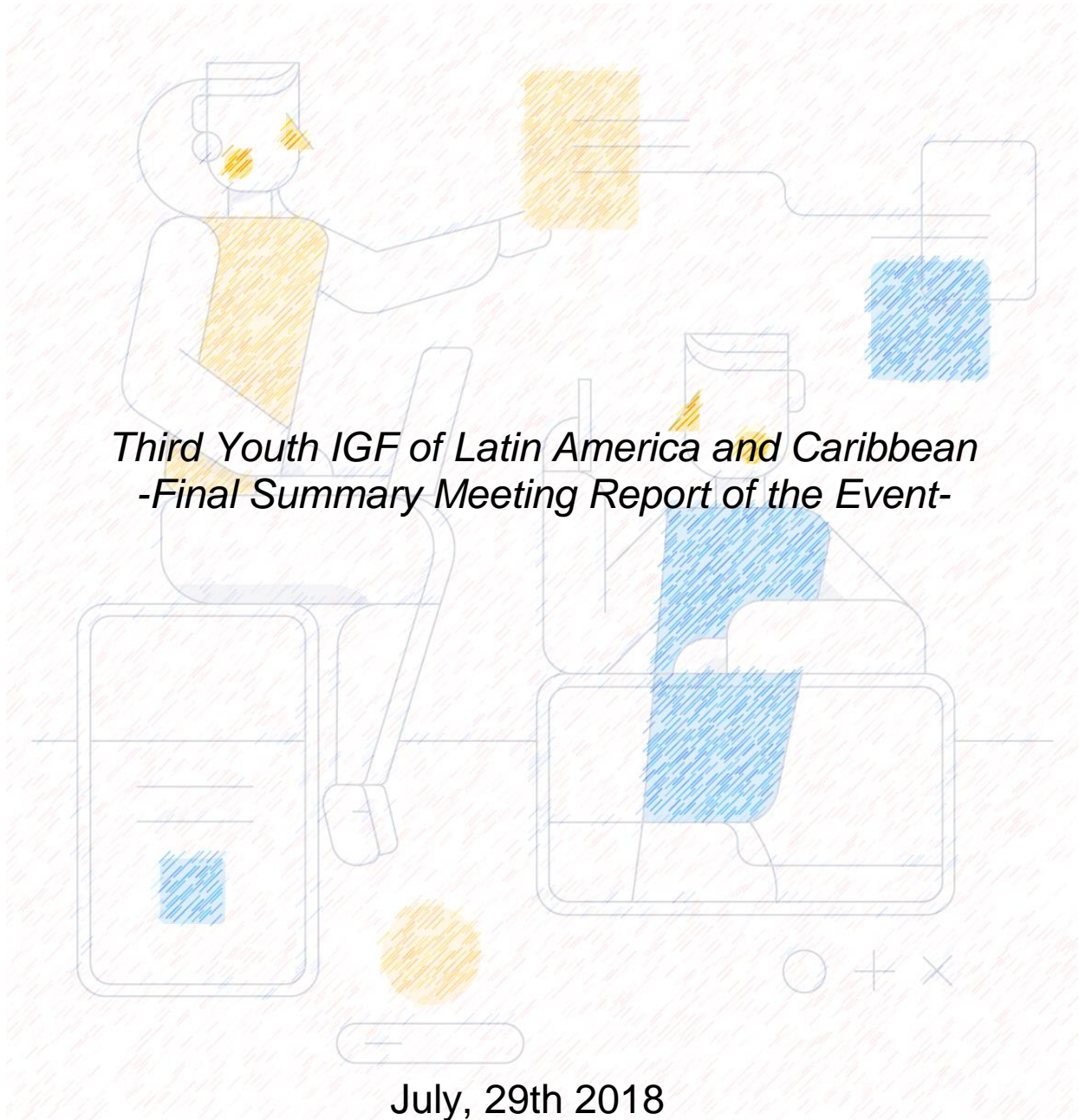

## About

The YouthLACIGF is an initiative born from the growing community of Latin American youth interested on issues related to the Internet. Given the active role that the youth have started taking in the digital ecosystem, this event was created with multi-sectoral characteristics, as a space to learn and create capacities and as a forum to debate new ideas and perspectives.

In 2016 the YouthLACIGF proposal emerged within the framework of the 9th LACIGF, which was conceived as a youth-driven initiative of Internet Governance. In 2017 the second edition was held following to continue with these efforts.

This third edition of the YouthLACIGF is not only a prove of the youth commitment with these discussions but also a milestone that marks the path we are going through on the developing of Internet in our region.

The whole organizational process is conducted in a communication with the IGF Secretariat and in accordance with the main IGF criteria and established procedures, as explained below.

**a. Description of the organizing process:**

The YouthLACIGF was an initiative proposed to create a space for young people from Latin America to discuss, from its own views, the main issues and the principal challenges they faced every day in Internet.

The agenda for this edition was defined by a Committee composed of representatives of all the stakeholders (except Government) involved in the organization process. This Committee was also responsible for defining the format of the discussions and other logistics details.

Also, for the first time in the history of the event, the Committee decided to merge the YouthLACIGF with the local youth-driven initiative "Youth@IGF Argentina". Both of them were divided in two blocks starting the discussion of different topics such as Cybersecurity, Access and Freedom of Speech Online with a regional approach (YouthLACIGF) and then focusing on issues like Intermediaries Liability, Digital Rights and Data Protection with a local approach (Youth@IGF Argentina). We find this interesting not only in terms of use of resources but also because the audience were exposed to a more diverse experience.

Like the previous year, YouthLACIGF used a Code of Conduct that was developed in 2017. We are committed to create a safe and positive environment, in order to encourage everyone to participate and build an inclusive community together. The Code of Conduct was sent to all the registered participants prior the event and published in the official site of the YouthLACIGF. It is available [here](#).

**b. Description of how the multistakeholder model is maintained:**

In order to create an Internet Governance Initiative that achieves the goals of openness, transparency, inclusiveness, non-commercial, and multi-stakeholder participation; the main organizers established a dialogue with other stakeholders interested in the event. At the end of July, we had the participation of 5 actors from different stakeholder groups which conform the Organization Committee.

The Committee decided to use the format of "Breakout groups" to maximize the participation of all attendees. The event was open to the public, free of charge and was widely disseminated in digital media.

This year it was not possible to provide streaming and recording services, but questions and comments were received through Twitter and Facebook using the hashtag #YouthLACIGF. The moderator also encouraged attendees to share their thoughts and opinions on social media.

A rapporteur was appointed per session, with three different rapporteurs. Reports will be available on the official YouthLACIGF website in late September.

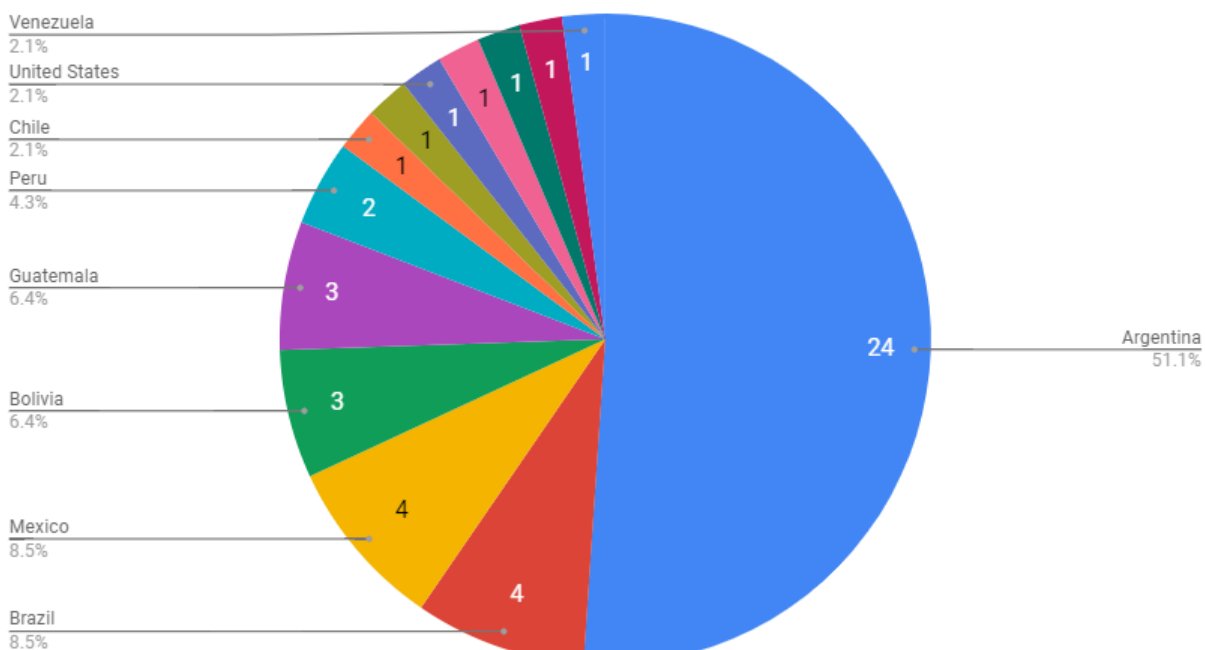

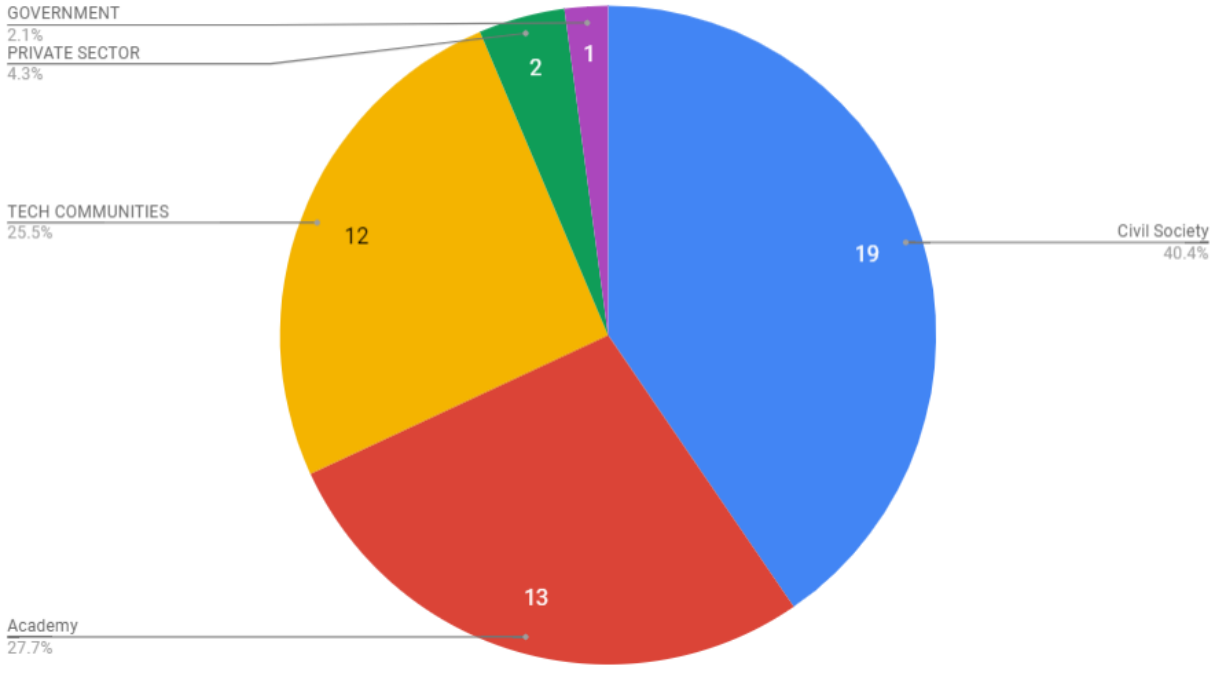

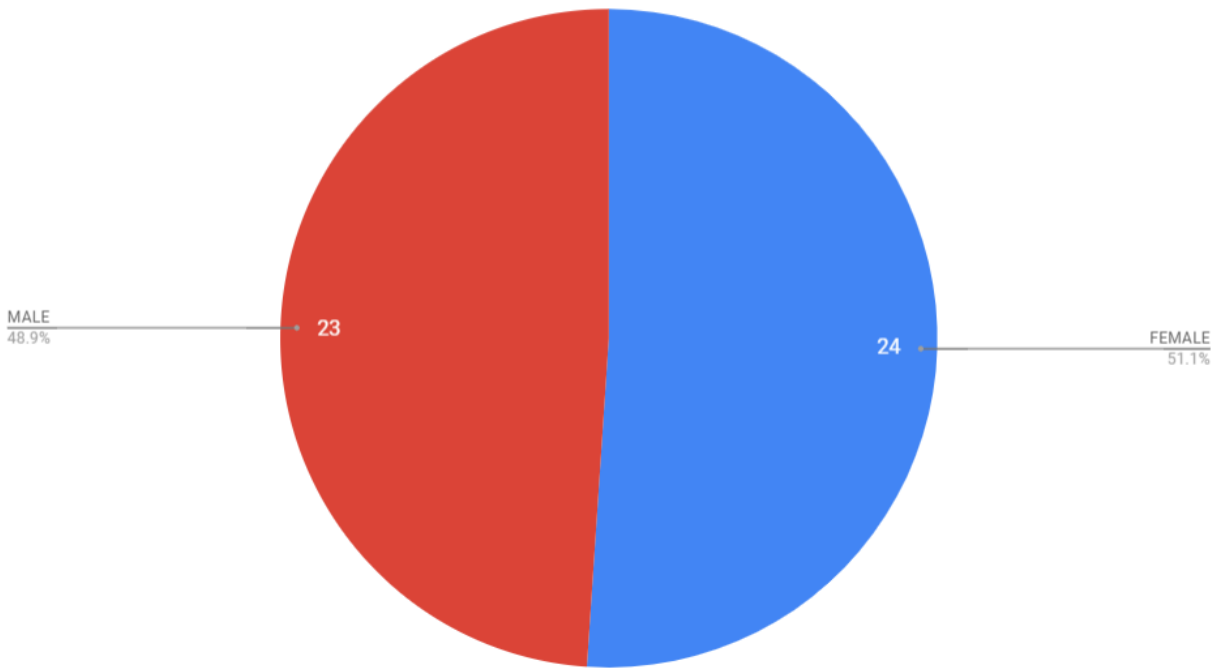
